Julie Kingsley opened the meeting and introductions were made.

This meeting is to review all Community Partner's Grant applications. After discussing all the criteria for applicants, Tim James made a motion to send out criteria to all members of the Local Water Plan Task Force, seconded by Marvel Haynes. Affirmative: All. Opposed: None. Motion carried.

Fish Hook Lake and River Association – Riverside Ave Storm Scepter application – Dan Kittilson made a motion to approve the application with the following conditions:

1. Want a rough estimate of what pollutants are coming into the river now from storm water.
2. When the city cleans the scepter, they should contact the lake association and the results of what was cleaned out should be measured, photographed and published.
3. There needs to be a maintenance agreement between the lake association and the city for 25 years.
4. The water testing should come directly from the pipe.
5. Lake association will work with the city on promoting rain gardens, education, etc for this project.

seconded by Bob Iles. Affirmative: All. Opposed: None. Motion carried.

Fish Hook Lake and River Association – Deane Point – application was unanimously denied because it did not meet the criteria.

Spider Lake Association – Causeway – Bob Iles made a motion to deny application as written, but would encourage a new application with the following conditions met:

1. Trees in the middle of the road need to be removed.
2. Add rain gardens to help with stormwater runoff.
3. Encourage use of actual public access.
4. Develop a plan to deny access from the causeway.

seconded by Sally Shearer. Affirmative: All. Opposed: None. Motion carried. Marvel Haynes did not vote she had to leave.

Belle Taine Lake Association – Stanwick – Dan Kittilson made a motion to approve the application with the condition that Belle Taine Lake Association has an agreement with Nevis Township that if there is any damage done to the project by township staff, the township will pay for the damages, seconded by Sally Shearer. Affirmative: All. Opposed: None. Motion carried. Marvel Haynes did not vote she had to leave.
