Actual Results	<p>Hubbard County SWCD identified 2 parcels that needed site visits and completed the needed BuffCAT reporting for Nov. 1, 2017 reporting. Upon inspection both parcels needed buffers. One landowner voluntarily complied with moving his fencing and excluding cattle from going to the river to drink and provided an alternated watering station. The area was allowed to re-vegetate naturally and it did. The other parcel applied for EQUIP assistance from NRCS and will have to wait until March to see if the project was selected. In the mean time a restoration plan was developed. A waiver for extending the time line of compliance to July 2018 was signed. The restoration plan would include an alternate water source on the east pasture, fencing exclusion of cattle from the Kabekona River, a controlled access across the river to get the cattle to the east pasture. Hubbard County has updated their aerial photography and a review of all Hubbard County parcels was done. With the new photos 8 more potential non-compliant sites were located. Letters of Site visits will need to be sent out to landowners and site visits will need to be conducted in the spring of 2018.</p>
