

Harbin Pear



The Harbin Pear prefers full sun and does best in moist, well-drained soils.

It has a medium growth rate with a mature height of 15 to 30 feet.

It is commonly used for field windbreaks and riparian plantings and is the hardiest of all pear trees.

The fruit from the pear tree can be used in jams and jellies and sweetens after a frost. The tree provides food for birds and small mammals as well as a nesting site.
