

Juneberry



The Juneberry prefers full sun but is shade tolerant and does best in moist, well-drained soils.

It has a moderate growth rate and has a mature height of 6 to 8 feet.

Birds, deer and raccoons love to eat the berry when they ripen to a blue color. Juneberries are most often used in pies, jams, jellies, wines and syrups. Some consider it an alternative to blueberries.
