

Sugar Maple



The Sugar Maple prefers full sun to partial shade and can adapt to a wide variety of soils, but does best in deep, moist, and well-drained soil.

It is considered a slow growing tree with a mature height of 60 to 75 feet.

Sugar Maple is prized for its sap used in making maple syrup. It is also prized for its hardwood, sometimes called hard maple. It provides browsing for deer, and squirrels feed on the seeds, buds, foliage and twigs.
