

# Highbush Cranberry



The Highbush Cranberry prefers full sun to light shade and does best in moist, well-drained soil.

It is a fast-growing shrub with a mature height of 6 to 15 feet.

The fruit from cranberry trees are for jellies, sauces and juices. The cranberries are eaten by a variety of animals such as birds, rabbits, squirrels, chipmunks, mice and grouse. The berries stay on the shrub into the winter months providing much needed food for animals.
