Our wild berry packet is a great option for those looking for a variety of native berry bushes, shrubs, and trees. Not only for their beautiful flowers but also for the fruit they produce. These species do not all flower and bear fruit at the same time so showy ornamental flowering will run from April through September and they will provide edible fruit from June through October. This selection provides a variety of plants types as well. Raspberries will provide dense cover near the forest floor growing thickets 3-6 feet tall. Elderberry and Serviceberry will provide tall shrubs to small trees that range from 20-30 feet tall when mature, up to the mulberry tree which will grow to be over 60 feet tall when mature. Elderberry and Mulberry grow well in moist soil conditions and have adaptable growth habits, while raspberry will prefer well drained soils on edge habitat features and in areas of recent disturbance like a timber harvest or wildfire. Serviceberry has an adaptive growth habitat and should do well in a variety of areas. All these species will not only provide beautiful flowers and tasty fruits for you throughout the growing season, they will also provide food and habitat for wildlife making this wild berry packet a great option.
