

HUBBARD COUNTY SWCD MONITORING PLAN FOR BUFFER COMPLIANCE TRACKING

MN § 5103F.48 RIPARIAN PROTECTION AND WATER QUALITY PRACTICES

1. COMPLIANCE TRACKING OF ALL PARCELS SUBJECT TO THE BUFFER LAW

All parcels in the county are to be reviewed within a 3-year timeframe.

The following Townships will be reviewed for compliance in 2019 and every third year thereafter:

- Badoura, Crow Wing Lake, Hubbard, Straight River, Todd, Henrietta, Nevis, and White Oak

The following Townships will be reviewed for compliance in 2020 and every third year thereafter:

- Akeley, Mantrap, Lake Emma, Arago, Clover, Clay, Thorpe, Steamboat River, Lakeport, and Hendrickson

The following Townships will be reviewed for compliance in 2021 and every third year thereafter:

- Lake George, Lake Alice, Hart Lake, Guthrie, Schoolcraft, Lake Hattie, Farden, Helga, Rockwood, and Fern

2. RANDOM SPOT CHECKS

Random spot checks will be done in addition to the tracking of all parcels within a 3-year span. These checks may be conducted via aerial photo review or on-site review depending on availability of updated aerial photos and the practice that is being checked/access to farms. A combination of both aerial and on-site review may also be used.

Hubbard County SWCD will conduct on site compliance reviews of parcels on a random spot check outside of their normal inspection year. Additionally, the SWCD will review parcels more frequently as needed for special circumstances:

- Previously non-compliant parcels
- No-till/Conservation tillage or cover crop alternative practice plans
- Variable width buffers
- Other Alternative Practice Plans
- Cost-share funded projects

3. PROCESS TO HANDLE COMPLAINTS

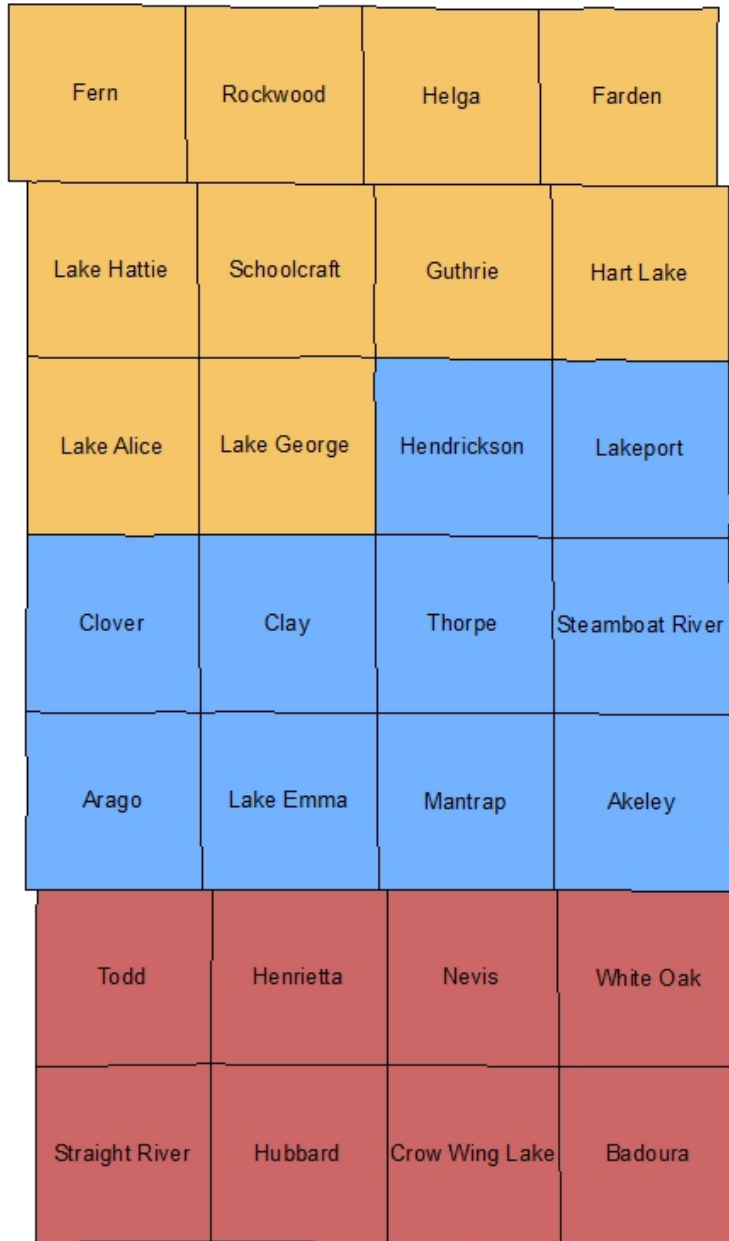
Hubbard County SWCD will accept complaints about individual parcels that are not in compliance in person at our office during normal business hours. Our location is:

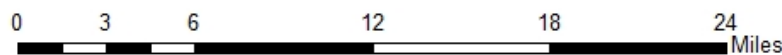
