

# Nannyberry



*Nannyberry Viburnum is a large growing “leggy” native shrub that can be pruned into a small tree form. It produces 2-3” clusters of white flowers in the spring. Mature fruit are black in color. Fall color is deep maroon to red. The glossy, green leaves are 1 1/2” wide and up to 4” long. Zone 2*

The Nannyberry is a slow-growing shrub and prefers full sun to partial shade and does best in a variety of soils.

The Nannyberry is very good for birds. It is an excellent source of food, nesting, perching and provides good cover. Other small animals benefit from the fruit and coverage, as well.

The berries are good for making jams and jellies.
